Summary

This Advice Letter is being filed to correct adopted values in Cal Water's preliminary Statement M, the Water Revenue Adjustment Mechanism (WRAM) balancing account and the Modified Cost Balancing Account (MCBA). The corrections relate to Advice Letter 1864, which was filed on July 10, 2008 in compliance with D.08-07-008. This advice letter effects two changes. First, as made necessary by the filing of Advice Letter 1882, this advice letter correctly sequences the changes to Preliminary Statement M and reflects the adopted values effective July 10, 2008. Second, this advice letter makes changes to correctly reflect the WRAM and MCBA quantities for the CHICO, EAST LOS ANGELES, LIVERMORE, LOS ALTOS, MID-PENINSULA, SALINAS, STOCKTON, and VISALIA DISTRICTS. This correction to a tier 1 advice letter should also be classified a tier 1 advice letter. Cal Water requests that the corrected preliminary statement become effective retroactively to July 10, 2008, the effective date of Advice Letter 1864 as discussed below.

Background

Cal Water filed Advice Letter 1864 as a tier 1 on July 10, 2008 in compliance with D.08-07-008. On August 9, 2008, Advice Letter 1864 was deemed approved under General Order 96-B. In the process of its review of WRAM and MCBA adopted quantities, Cal Water discovered errors in Preliminary Statement M adopted quantities as filed with Advice Letter 1864 after approval. Therefore Cal Water is filing a subsequent advice letter to correct the original filing.



It is in the interest of ratepayers and the public that the quantities upon which the WRAM and MCBA mechanisms rely are accurate. It is essential, for continuity, that these preliminary statement sheets correcting Advice Letter 1864 be approved, subsequent to the approval of Advice Letter 1882, on their original effective date of July 10, 2008. Therefore, Cal Water respectfully requests that this advice letter be made effective retroactive to the original effective date of Advice Letter 1864, which it replaces.

Cal Water has undergone an extensive audit of these spreadsheets over the last 60 days to correct for any errors. The nature of these errors does not modify any revenue requirement approved by previous Commission decisions or advice letter approvals.

Cal Water respectfully requests that the WRAM preliminary statement proposed here be adopted as a replacement for the preliminary statement now effective. Cal Water will be filing subsequent preliminary statement corrections, with appropriate effective dates, for advice letters 1865 (effective July 11, 2008), 1866-A (effective July 15, 2008), 1867 (Effective August 3, 2008), 1868 (Effective August 4, 2008), 1869 through 1871 (Effective August 6, 2008), 1878-A (Effective August 25, 2008), and 1879 (effective August 27, 2008). Cal Water does not intend to file for additional rate relief until these matters are corrected and the preliminary statement accurately records the adopted quantities necessary for processing the WRAM balancing account and the MCBA.

Discussion

The specific changes requested here are:

1. Cal Water made minor corrections to the monthly split of revenues for the Chico, Los Altos-Suburban, Mid-Peninsula, Salinas, and Stockton Districts. Cal Water's stated monthly breakdown did not follow its stated methodology of using a three-year average of monthly sales, due to a spreadsheet error.
2. Cal Water corrected the monthly split of revenues for the Livermore District. The original order of months was inverted, showing greater revenue in winter, which does not reflect the sales or revenue pattern of the district. Also, Cal Water made a minor correction to the split of WRAM and non-WRAM revenues in Livermore to reflect adopted rates.
3. Cal Water corrected revenue components for the East Los Angeles District. Through a transcription error, the Mid-Peninsula adopted quantities were reflected in the East Los Angeles section.
4. Cal Water corrected the overall revenue requirement of the Visalia District to include the proper revenue amounts generated from 1) residential flat rate tariffs effective with Advice Letter 1864, and 2) the rate phase-in surcharge for metered customers.

Requested Effective Date

The original rates filed in Advice Letter 1864 were made effective July 10, 2008. Because this filing corrects Advice Letter 1864, this filing should be made effective on July 10, 2008. Subsequent filings will replace all prior modifications of Preliminary Statement M.



Notice

This advice letter is filed in compliance with D.08-07-008 and General Order 96-B. It will not increase any rate or charge. It will not result in the diminishment of service to any individual. No customer notice is therefore required. In accordance with General Order 96-B, General Rule 4.3 and 7.2 and Water Industry Rule 4.1, a copy of this advice letter will be mailed or electronically transmitted on September 30, 2008 to competing and adjacent utilities and other utilities or interested parties having requested such notification.

Response or Protest

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Division of Water and Audits within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:
