Advice Letter No. 1887

CALIFORNIA WATER SERVICE COMPANY (U 60 W)

To The Public Utilities Commission of the State of California:

California Water Service Company (Cal Water) hereby transmits for filing the changes in its tariffs applicable to its CHICO, EAST LOS ANGELES, LIVERMORE, LOS ALTOS-SUBURBAN, MID-PENINSULA, SALINAS, STOCKTON, AND VISALIA DISTRICTS shown in Attachment 1 and four copies of each are attached hereto.

Summary

This filing proposes surcharges to recover the difference between interim rates established by Advice Letter 1861, effective July 1, 2008, and final rates established by Advice Letter 1864, effective July 10, 2008 in compliance with D.08-07-007. The recovery is through a 12-month surcharge on all water service. This filing was authorized by Ordering Paragraph 21 of D.08-07-008. Executive Director Clanon, in his letter of September 25, 2008, allowed Cal Water until October 17, 2008 to comply with the order. Though this is a compliance filing, Cal Water requests this Advice Letter be treated as a Tier 2 filing.

Background

Advice Letter 1861, approved July 1, 2008, was authorized by ALJ Thomas' May 27, 2008 ruling to allow an interim increase in rates for districts included in A.07-07-001. The interim increase adopted was subject to adjustment, upward or downward, in order to recover the final adopted revenue requirement effective back to July 1, 2008. D.08-07-008 was issued on July 10, 2008. Cal Water incorporated the rates and revenue requirements from the decision into its Advice Letter 1864, which was effective July 10, 2008.

D.08-07-008 provides a process for recovering the adjustment for the interim rate period. Ordering paragraph 21 states:

21. The surcharge to true-up the interim rates authorized in ALJ Thomas' May 27, 2008 ruling shall be based on the methodology set forth in D.07-12-055 and shall be filed by compliance letter within 60 days of the effective date of this decision.

D.07-12-055 required recovery based on "the actual loss or gain in each district's revenue, determined by applying the rate differential to the actual quantities of water sales and the actual number of customers." (Decision at 71) The surcharge is for twelve months. Cal Water has simplified its approach to the interim shortfall calculation because the interim period is covered by the WRAM/MCBA balancing accounts established in Advice Letter 1863-A¹. Since the WRAM balancing mechanism already accounts for sales changes, Cal

Workpapers have been provided to Division of Water and Audit staff showing derivation of the surcharges.

In addition, Cal Water requested and was granted an extension to file this compliance advice letter until today, October 17, 2008. Executive Director Clanon’s letter is included with the workpapers.

Impact on WRAM/MCBA

Cal Water is requesting that the surcharge revenue be excluded from WRAM, both for adopted and recorded revenues. Cal Water does not propose changes to its preliminary statement M for this twelve-month surcharge.

Requested Effective Date

Cal Water has previously noted some difficulty with its tariff filings due to new rate designs and ratemaking mechanisms adopted this year. Until these difficulties can be conclusively resolved, Cal Water is filing all potential Tier 1 advice letters as Tier 2. Therefore, Cal Water requests the tariffs attached to this Advice Letter become effective on November 16, 2008, 30 days from filing, upon staff approval. As required in General Order 96-B, this filing will be deemed effective on that date if not suspended or earlier approved by Commission staff.



Notice

This advice letter is filed in compliance with D.08-07-008. No customer notice is required as the amounts requested are contained within the noticed amounts in A.07-07-001.

In accordance with General Order 96-B, General Rule 4.3 and 7.2 and Water Industry Rule 4.1, a copy of this advice letter will be mailed or electronically transmitted on October 20, 2008 to competing and adjacent utilities and other utilities or interested parties having requested such notification.

Response or Protest

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Division of Water and Audits within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:
