**Summary**

The purpose of this supplemental advice letter is to provide updated page numbers for the Table of Contents and tariff schedules for Advice Letter 1960. No changes are sought to the original filing of AL 1960 for the filing the fire-flow test charge for the eight districts of the 2007 General Rate Case filed on September 2, 2009.

**Background**

Currently Cal Water does not charge a fee for performing a fire-flow test. Consequently, the cost for performing the service is passed on to the rate-payers. Paragraphs 16 and 17 of the Conclusions of Law of D.08-07-008 state:



16. Those who request a fire-flow test should pay the cost of performing the test.

17. It is reasonable to charge \$450 for a fire-flow test in Cal Water's Eight Districts in this GRC.

### **Discussion**

Cal Water is complying with ordering paragraph 23 of D.08-07-008, which states:

1. Cal Water is authorized to file Tier 1 advice letters to adopt a fire-flow testing fee applicable to the districts in this proceeding.

Cal Water is proposing to implement tariff stipulating a charge of \$450 per fire-flow test service performed for the eight districts adopted in D.08-07-008. Although the decision stipulates the advice letter to be Tier 1 Cal Water is requesting this advice letter to be Tier 2, effective in thirty days.

### **Requested Effective Date**

Under General Order 96-B, Water Industry Rule 7.3.1, as modified by Resolution W-4664 this is a Tier 1 advice letter. As provided in GO-96-B, General Rule 7.3.3, Cal Water requests this advice letter to be classified as Tier 2 with an effective date of October 2, 2009, the effective date of Advice Letter 1960.

### **Notice**

This advice letter is filed in compliance with Standard Practice U-08-W. No customer notice is required. In accordance with General Order 96-B, General Rule 4.3 and 7.2 and Water Industry Rule 4.1, a copy of this advice letter will be mailed or electronically transmitted on November 24, 2009 to competing and adjacent utilities and other utilities or interested parties having requested such notification.

### **Response or Protest**

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or

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(5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or

(6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Division of Water and Audits within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:

Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform the Division of Water and Audits, within the 20 day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

The advice letter process does not provide for any responses, protests or comments, except for the utility's reply, after the 20 day comment period.

Replies: The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Each reply must be received by the Division of Water and Audits within 5 business days after the end of the protest period, and shall be served on the same day to the person who filed the protest or response.
