**Advice Letter No. 1972**

**CALIFORNIA WATER SERVICE COMPANY (U 60 W)**

To The Public Utilities Commission of the State of California:

California Water Service Company (Cal Water) hereby transmits for filing the changes in its tariff schedules shown on Attachment 1 for eight of its districts and four copies of each are attached hereto.

**Summary**

This filing implements surcharges in Section 5.5 of the settlement agreement between California Water Service Company (Cal Water) and the Commission's Division of Ratepayer Advocates (DRA) that were approved in Ordering Paragraphs 1 and 22 of D.08-07-008. Section 5.5 allows recovery of the General Office Synergies Memorandum Account.

**Background**

On July 10, 2008, the Commission issued D.08-07-008, which in Ordering Paragraph 1 approved a settlement agreement between Cal Water and DRA. In Ordering Paragraph 22, the Commission stated:

22. Cal Water is authorized to file Tier 1 advice letters to request amortization of the balancing and memorandum accounts adopted in Paragraphs 5.4 and 5.5 of the Settlement.

Section 5.5 in the settlement agreement provides for recovery of the General Office Synergies Memorandum Account. Below is Section 5.5.

**5.5. RECOVERY OF GENERAL OFFICE SYNERGIES MEMORANDUM ACCOUNT**

The Parties agree as stated in DRA's report to allow Cal Water to amortize the remaining balances in its general office synergies memorandum accounts as proposed in the applications. Those memorandum accounts stopped accruing entries at the effective date of rates in D.05-07-022, but were only amortized through January 1, 2005 in the last GRC. Surcharge values and duration are as



follows (taken from DRA reports, exhibits 201-208):

Chico	Surcharge of \$0.29 per customer per month for twelve months.
East Los Angeles	Surcharge of \$0.33 per customer per month for twelve months.
Livermore	Surcharge of \$0.31 per customer per month for twelve months.
Los Altos	Surcharge of \$0.35 per customer per month for twelve months.
Mid-Peninsula	Surcharge of \$0.28 per customer per month for twelve months.
Salinas	Surcharge of \$0.37 per customer per month for twelve months.
Stockton	Surcharge of \$0.29 per customer per month for twelve months.
Visalia	Surcharge of \$0.18 per customer per month for twelve months.

### **Requested Effective Date**

Under General Order 96-B, Water Industry Rule 7.3.1, this is a Tier 1 advice letter. Due to its agreement with DWA staff, Cal Water requests this advice letter be classified as Tier 2 with a later effective date of February 11, 2010.

### **Notice**

This advice letter is filed in compliance with Standard Practice U-08-W. No customer notice is required as the request is in compliance with a properly noticed general rate case application. In accordance with General Order 96-B, General Rule 4.3 and 7.2 and Water Industry Rule 4.1, a copy of this advice letter will be mailed or electronically transmitted on January 12, 2010 to competing and adjacent utilities and other utilities or interested parties having requested such notification.

### **Response or Protest**

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or

(6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Division of Water and Audits within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:

Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform the Division of Water and Audits, within the 20 day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

The advice letter process does not provide for any responses, protests or comments, except for the utility's reply, after the 20 day comment period.

Replies: The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Each reply must be received by the Division of Water and Audits within 5 business days after the end of the protest period, and shall be served on the same day to the person who filed the protest or response.
