APPLICABILITY

Applicable to all metered water service except that provided to single-family residential customers.

Bakersfield and vicinity, Kern County.

1. All bills are subject to the reimbursement fees set forth on Schedule UF.
2. All bills are subject to any applicable surcharges on Schedules RSF and LIRA-SC.
3. Qualifying non-profit group living facilities, agricultural employee housing facilities, and migrant farm worker housing centers are eligible for credits as shown on Schedule LIRA. ( D )
4. A capital infrastructure surcharge of \$0.0043 per 100 Cu. Ft. of water used is to be applied to the quantity rates, beginning December 17, 2010, the effective date of Advice Letter 2009-A, as authorized in Decision 07-12-055.
5. A WRAM-MCBA true-up surcredit of \$0.0897 per 100 cu. ft. of water used is to be applied to the quantity rates for 12 months beginning April 14, 2011, the effective date of Advice Letter 2029-A. ( D )
