3. Qualifying low-income individually metered residential customers are eligible for credits as shown on Schedule LIRA. ( D )
  
4. A capital infrastructure surcharge of \$0.0043 per 100 Cu. Ft. of water used is to be applied to the quantity rates, beginning December 17, 2010, the effective date of Advice Letter 2009-A, as authorized in Decision 07-12-055.
5. A WRAM-MCBA true-up surcredit of \$0.0897 per 100 cu. ft. of water used is to be applied to the quantity rates for 12 months beginning April 14, 2011, the effective date of Advice Letter 2029-A. ( D )
