Chico-Hamilton City Tariff Area
RESIDENTIAL FLAT RATE SERVICE

This tariff has been filed with the California Public Utilities Commission and is effective 2/1/12, subject to refund, until final commission approval.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to all flat rate residential water service.

TERRITORY

Chico and vicinity, Butte County, and Hamilton City and vicinity, Glenn County.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. The above flat rates apply to service connections not larger than one inch in diameter.
2. All service not covered by the above classifications shall be furnished only on a metered basis.
3. For service covered by the above classifications, if the utility or the customer so elects, a meter shall be installed and service provided under Schedule No. CH-1-R, Residential Metered Service.
4. This Schedule is closed to all new connections as of Jan 20, 1992, the effective date of Advice Letter No. 1232.
5. All bills are subject to the reimbursement fees set forth on Schedule UF.
6. All bills are subject to any applicable surcharges on Schedules RSF and LIRA-SC.
7. Qualifying low-income flat rate residential customers are eligible for credits as shown on Schedule LIRA.
8. A capital infrastructure surcharge of \$0.53 per service per month is to be added to each bill, beginning December 20, 2010, the effective date of Advice Letter 2014, as authorized in Decision 08-07-008.
9. An ICBA surcredit of \$0.1840 per service per month is to be added to each bill for 12 months beginning April 1, 2011, the effective date of Advice Letter 2024-A, in accordance with Commission Decision 10-12-017.
10. A conservation surcredit of \$0.12 per service per month is to be added to each bill for 12 months beginning April 1, 2011, the effective date of Advice Letter 2026, in accordance with Commission Decision 10-12-017.
11. A WRAM-MCBA true-up surcredit of \$0.1833 per service per month is to be applied to each bill for 24 months beginning April 14, 2011, the effective date of Advice Letter 2029-A.
