NONRESIDENTIAL METERED SERVICE

This tariff has been filed with the California Public Utilities Commission and is effective 2/1/12, subject to refund, until final commission approval.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to all metered water service except that provided to single-family residential customers.

TERRITORY

Dixon and vicinity, Solano County.

The service charge is a readiness-to-serve charge which is applicable to all metered service and to which is added the charge for water used computed at the quantity rate.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. All bills are subject to the reimbursement fees set forth on Schedule UF.
2. All bills are subject to any applicable surcharges on Schedules RSF and LIRA-SC.
3. Qualifying non-profit group living facilities, agricultural employee housing facilities, and migrant farm worker housing centers are eligible for credits as shown on Schedule LIRA.
4. A surcharge of \$0.1048 per 100 cubic feet of water is to be added to each bill for 36 months on or after January 1, 2011, to reflect interim rates authorized by the Commission in Decision 10-12-017.
5. A WRAM-MCBA true-up surcharge of \$0.0871 per 100 cu. ft. of water used is to be applied to the quantity rates for 36 months beginning July 23, 2010, the effective date of Advice Letter 1996-A.
6. An ICBA surcredit of \$0.7831 per service per month is to be added to each bill for 12 months beginning April 1, 2011, the effective date of Advice Letter 2024-A, in accordance with Commission Decision 10-12-017.
7. A WRAM-MCBA true-up surcharge of \$0.1377 per 100 cu. ft. of water used is to be applied to the quantity rates for 36 months beginning April 14, 2011, the effective date of Advice Letter 2034.
