This tariff has been filed with the California Public Utilities Commission and is effective 2/1/12, subject to refund, until final commission approval.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to all metered water service provided to single-family residential customers.

TERRITORY

Hermosa Beach, Redondo Beach, Torrance, and vicinity, Los Angeles County

The service charge is a readiness-to-serve charge which is applicable to all metered service and to which is added the charge for water used computed at the quantity rates.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. All bills are subject to the reimbursement fees set forth on Schedule UF.
2. All bills are subject to any applicable surcharges on Schedules RSF and LIRA-SC.
3. Qualifying low-income individually metered residential customers are eligible for credits as shown on Schedule LIRA.
4. Any service to a residential customer, not exceeding two units, on a lot size of 10,000 square feet or less, who requires a one-inch meter only because of fire flow requirements to a fire sprinkler system will be billed at the above 5/8 x 3/4-inch meter service charge, which equals \$9.06 per month.
5. A WRAM-MCBA true-up surcharge of \$0.1774 per 100 cu. ft. of water used is to be applied to the quantity rates for 24 months beginning July 23, 2010, the effective date of Advice Letter 1996-A.
6. A surcharge of \$0.0712 per 100 cubic feet of water is to be added to each bill for 24 months on or after January 1, 2011, to reflect interim rates authorized by the Commission in Decision 10-12-017.
7. A conservation surcredit of \$0.58 per service per month is to be added to each bill for 12 month: beginning April 1, 2011, the effective date of Advice Letter 2025, in accordance with Commission Decision 10-12-017.
8. A WRAM-MCBA true-up surcharge of \$0.1585 per 100 cu. ft. of water used is to be applied to the quantity rates for 24 months beginning April 14, 2011, the effective date of Advice Letter 2029-A
