NONRESIDENTIAL METERED SERVICE

This tariff has been filed with the California Public Utilities Commission and is effective 1/1/12, subject to refund, until final commission approval.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to all metered water service except that provided to single-family residential customers.

TERRITORY

Palos Verdes Estates, Rolling Hills, Rolling Hills Estates, Lomita, Rancho Palos Verdes, and vicinity, Los Angeles County.

The service charge is a readiness-to-serve charge which is applicable to all metered service and to which is added the charge for water used computed at the quantity rate.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. All bills are subject to the reimbursement fees set forth on Schedule UF.
2. All bills are subject to any applicable surcharges on Schedules RSF and LIRA-SC.
3. Qualifying non-profit group living facilities, agricultural employee housing facilities, and migrant farm worker housing centers are eligible for credits as shown on Schedule LIRA. (D)
4. A surcharge of \$0.0524 per 100 cubic feet of water is to be added to each bill for 24 months on or after January 1, 2011, to reflect interim rates authorized by the Commission in Decision 10-12-017.
5. An ICBA surcharge of \$0.0623 per 100 cu. ft. of water used is to be applied to the quantity rates for 12 months beginning April 1, 2011, the effective date of Advice Letter 2024-A, in accordance with Commission Decision 10-12-007.
6. A conservation surcredit of \$0.19 per service per month is to be added to each bill for 12 months beginning April 1, 2011, the effective date of Advice Letter 2025, in accordance with Commission Decision 10-12-017.
7. A WRAM-MCBA true-up surcharge of \$0.1200 per 100 cu. ft. of water used is to be applied to the quantity rates for 24 months beginning April 14, 2011, the effective date of Advice Letter 2029-A. (D)
