Salinas Tariff Area

NONRESIDENTIAL METERED SERVICE

This tariff has been filed with the California Public Utilities Commission and is effective 1/1/12, subject to refund, until final commission approval.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to all metered water service except that provided to single-family residential customers.

TERRITORY

Salinas and vicinity, Monterey County, including the Bolsa Knolls, Las Lomas, and Oak Hills tariff areas.

The service charge is a readiness-to-serve charge which is applicable to all metered service and to which is added the charge for water used computed at the quantity rates.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. All bills are subject to the reimbursement fees set forth on Schedule UF.
2. All bills are subject to any applicable surcharges on Schedules RSF and LIRA-SC.
3. Qualifying non-profit group living facilities, agricultural employee housing facilities, and migrant farm worker housing centers are eligible for credits as shown on Schedule LIRA. (D)
4. A WRAM-MCBA true-up surcharge of \$0.1044 per 100 cu. ft. of water used is to be applied to the quantity rates for 24 months beginning July 23, 2010, the effective date of Advice Letter 1996-A.
5. An ICBA surcredit of \$1.1630 per service per month is to be added to each bill for 12 months beginning April 1, 2011, the effective date of Advice Letter 2024-A, in accordance with Commission Decision 10-12-017.
6. A conservation surcredit of \$0.38 per service per month is to be added to each bill for 12 months beginning April 1, 2011, the effective date of Advice Letter 2026, in accordance with Commission Decision 10-12-017.
7. A WRAM-MCBA true-up surcharge of \$0.1228 per 100 cu. ft. of water used is to be applied to the quantity rates for 36 months beginning April 14, 2011, the effective date of Advice Letter 2029-A. (D)
