2018 ANNUAL SAVINGS

Conservation programs utilized by customers in Cal Water's Dixon District in 2018 amounted to a savings of 128,000 gallons.



2018 LIFETIME SAVINGS

Conservation programs implemented in 2018 will save **1.2 million gallons (MG)** over their lifetime.



LIFETIME CUMULATIVE SAVINGS

Programs implemented since 2011 will result in a lifetime cumulative savings of **51 MG**.
