2018 ANNUAL SAVINGS

Conservation programs utilized by customers in Cal Water's King City District in 2018 amounted to a savings of **34,000 gallons**.



2018 LIFETIME SAVINGS

Conservation programs implemented in 2018 will save **163,000 gallons** over their lifetime.



LIFETIME CUMULATIVE SAVINGS

Programs implemented since 2011 will result in a lifetime cumulative savings of **32 million gallons.**
