2018 ANNUAL SAVINGS

Conservation programs utilized by customers in Cal Water's Livermore District in 2018 amounted to a savings of 2 million gallons (MG).

2018 LIFETIME SAVINGS

Conservation programs implemented in 2018 will save 23 MG over their lifetime.



LIFETIME CUMULATIVE SAVINGS

Programs implemented since 2011 will result in a lifetime cumulative savings of 866 MG.
