2018 ANNUAL SAVINGS

Conservation programs utilized by customers in Cal Water's Selma District in 2018 amounted to a savings of 181,000 gallons.



2018 LIFETIME SAVINGS

Conservation programs implemented in 2018 will save 1.4 million gallons (MG) over their lifetime.



LIFETIME CUMULATIVE SAVINGS

Programs implemented since 2011 will result in a lifetime cumulative savings of 234 MG.
