Cal Water would like to make you aware of a construction project tentatively scheduled beginning the week of October 12, 2015. The project will allow for pump station improvements and the abandonment of an 8" main in the multi-use trail along the eastern shoulder of Portola Road from Montecito Road to Santa Maria Avenue. The work will be done Monday through Friday between the hours of 9:00 AM and 5:00 PM.

The proposed improvements ensure that we have a reliable supply of high-quality water to meet the community's needs at all times. The project will include approximately 2 miles of transmission pipeline in Portola Road, from Sand Hill Road to Old La Honda Road and Tadin Lane to Stonegate Road. Traffic control will be implemented to allow crews to safely work in the area. Residents should plan for extra time and pay attention to where crews are working to allow safe access into and out of driveways and intersections. Please avoid the work area when possible. Please contact us if you have any concerns.

After the new main passes the disinfection testing, we will return to tie in the new main to the water system and transfer remaining service connections to the new main. You will be notified with a door tag 48 hours prior to any planned service interruption. During construction, you may experience a brief disruption in water service. We will make every effort to provide advance notice prior to any service interruptions. Please note that temporary asphalt will be applied to the excavated areas until permanent paving is completed. Our goal is to complete the project by May 2016.

*Schedule summary – weather permitting:*

October 2015 to December 2015	Water main install between Sand Hill Rd to Old La Honda and Sausal Creek Crossing near 828 Portola Road
Nov. 2015 to March 2016	Water main install between Tadin Lane to Stonegate Rd
April to May 2016	Tie-Ins and Paving
