

The 18-Month Review Process of Our Triennial Infrastructure Improvement Plan

After reviewing our historical and projected costs, and identifying needed water system improvements, Cal Water submits an application to the California Public Utilities Commission.

The Commission may host a public hearing locally to receive input from customers on the application.

The assigned Administrative Law Judge issues a proposed decision, which may be different than our application.



The Public Advocates Office and other parties analyze our application and make their own recommendations.

The Commission may hold a formal hearing similar to a court proceeding if a settlement cannot be reached.

Commissioners vote to adopt, amend, modify, or reject the Administrative Law Judge's proposed decision.
