**Advice Letter No. 2122**

**CALIFORNIA WATER SERVICE COMPANY (U 60 W)**

To The Public Utilities Commission of the State of California:

California Water Service Company (Cal Water) hereby transmits for filing the following changes in its tariff applicable to the districts of Antelope Valley, Bakersfield, Bayshore, Bear Gulch, Dominguez, Dixon, East Los Angeles, Hermosa Redondo, King City, Kern River Valley, Livermore, Los Altos, Marysville, Oroville, Palos Verdes, Redwood Valley, Salinas, Selma, Stockton, Visalia, and Willows and four copies of each are attached hereto:

**Summary of Requests**

This advice letter is filed in compliance with Ordering Paragraph 8 of Decision (D.) 10-12-017 and Preliminary Statement Z, Conservation Expense One-Way Balancing Account (CEBA), which was authorized by D.10-12-017 and approved in Advice Letter 2016. California Water Service Company (Cal Water) requests approval for the following:

- (1) Beginning April 30, 2014, Cal Water requests authorization to implement flat (per-service) surcredits for the districts identified above to amortize the balances in the one-way conservation balancing account authorized in its 2009 GRC. The refunds reflect the amount of conservation expenses authorized for each district that were not spent over the three-year rate case period, plus interest. The refunds will be returned to customers as a one-time surcredit in 10 districts, and as a 12-month surcredit in 11 districts;
- (2) If creation of the District-Specific Balancing Accounts described in the Proposed Settlement Agreement in A.12-07-007 (2012 GRC) is approved, Cal Water requests authority to transfer any balances that remain in the CEBA to the appropriate



district-specific balancing accounts at the end of the 12-month amortization period (for both one-time surcredits and 12-month surcredits), and;

- (3) After the balances in the CEBA are fully amortized (or transferred to the general balancing account for each district), Cal Water requests authority to close the CEBA and removed Preliminary Statement Z from its tariff.

**Discussion**

Conservation Budget: In Cal Water’s 2009 General Rate Case (Application 09-07-001), the Commission adopted a three-year conservation expense budget totaling \$29,056,000 for Cal Water’s 23 districts (to be expended over the rate case period of 2011-2013). The funds are not transferable between districts, but may be carried forward to subsequent years within each district.

Unspent Funds and Refunds: The table below provides the unspent conservation budget for each district as of December 31, 2014. Section 4.b of Preliminary Statement Z requires Cal Water to file an advice letter by March 31, 2014 to refund the balances, and specifies the methods for the refunds, either through a one-time surcredit, or a 12-month surcredit.

Section 4 of Preliminary Statement Z states:

*b. If the total amount recorded in section 3.g. for any district as of December 31, 2013 is a positive number (meaning accumulated expenditures are less than the three-year authorization), Cal Water shall file an advice letter by March 31, 2014 to refund this amount to ratepayers. This refund should be made as a one-time Conservation surcredit unless the average surcredit per customer exceeds 50% of the adopted monthly service charge for a residential 5/8 X 3/4-inch meter, in which case the surcredit should be made over a 12- month period.*

District-Specific Balancing Accounts: In Cal Water’s outstanding 2012 GRC, A.12-07-007, the Proposed Settlement Agreement filed on October 31, 2013, if adopted, would create a general balancing account for each ratemaking area (referenced generally as “districts”). The reasons for and mechanics of the district-specific balancing accounts are described on pages 63-64 of the Proposed Settlement Agreement as follows:

*ISSUE: Cal Water identified accounts with residual amounts left over after amortization (for the Commission-authorized time period) had occurred, including the WCBA (an older conservation balancing account associated with Preliminary Statement N) and the obsolete balancing accounts for purchased water and power (the “Incremental Cost Balancing Accounts” or “ICBAs”). Because the surcharges or surcredits for amortization are generally calculated based upon the authorized sales and services for each district, “under-“ or “over-“ amortization occurs to the extent that “actual” sales and services differ from the “authorized” sales and services used to calculate the surcharges/surcredits. Since Cal Water’s July 2012*



*GRC Application, the amortization periods for additional accounts have ended, leaving residual balances.*

*RESOLUTION: As discussed above, and in Section A(3) of this chapter, regarding small residual amounts in memo and balancing accounts, the Parties agree that certain balances may be transferred to “district-specific” general balancing accounts, and aggregated for amortization. Cal Water agrees that balances should be maintained by ratemaking area. The conditions of the general district balancing accounts are as follows:*

- a. Each ratemaking area will have an associated “general balancing account” (referred to as a “general district balancing account”);*
- b. Each general district balancing account may be amortized consistent with the Commission’s standard practices (2% of last adopted revenue requirement), or in a GRC, and;*
- c. For accounts for which the Commission has authorized a fixed period of amortization, the small residual balances that result from under- or over-amortization may be put into a general district balancing account.*

Timing for this filing: In D.10-12-017, the Commission decision concluding Cal Water’s 2009 GRC, Ordering Paragraph 8 addressed the filing deadline for balances in the newly adopted CEBA, as follows:

*8. Within 90 days of the effective date of the rates adopted in the next general rate case, California Water Service Company shall file a Tier 2 advice letter comparing the authorized and actual conservation expenses from this general rate case for each district, and amortizing any unspent funds and accrued interest to customers through a 12-month surcredit on the service charge. The accrual of interest and the interest rate are specified in Section 5, One-Way Balancing Account, of the revised settlement agreement adopted in Ordering Paragraph 1.*

At this time, there are no “rates adopted in the next general rate case.” Cal Water’s 2012 GRC proceeding, A.12-07-007, has been submitted for Commission consideration, however there no final (or proposed) decision has been issued. Section 4.b of Preliminary Statement Z, however, as quoted above, requires Cal Water to file an advice letter for conservation refunds by “March 31, 2014.”

No other expenses can be booked to the CEBA for activities after December 31, 2013, so the end balances for each district are known, and will not change except to reflect additional interest. In an abundance of caution, and because these are known amounts owed to ratepayers, Cal Water is filing this advice letter to meet the deadline in Preliminary Statement Z, rather than waiting until new rates are adopted in A.12-07-007.



## **Conclusion**

For the reasons discussed above, Cal Water requests authority to amortize the CEBA and, after the 12-month amortization period, to transfer any residual amounts to district-specific balancing accounts and remove Preliminary Statement Z from Cal Water's tariff.

## **Requested Effective Date**

As provided in D.10-12-017, Ordering Paragraph 8, Cal Water requests this advice letter to be classified as Tier 2, effective April 30, 2014.

## **Notice**

This advice letter is filed in compliance with Commission orders, Standard Practice U-27-W, and General Order 96-B (both General Rules and Water Industry Rules). Specifically:

- General Rule 4.2 and Water Industry Rule 3.1 of GO 96-B require certain individual customer notice of advice letters that request "higher rates or charges, or more restrictive terms or conditions, than those currently in effect." These requirements do not apply to this advice letter because Cal Water is not seeking a higher rate, or more restrictive terms or conditions.
- General Rules 4.3, 4.4, and 7.2, and Water Industry Rule 4.1, of GO 96-B require mail or electronic service of advice letters on certain entities. Cal Water will mail or electronically transmit this advice letter to the Office of Ratepayer Advocates, competing and adjacent utilities, and other utilities or interested parties having requested such filing notification.
- Water Industry Rule 3.3 of GO 96-B requires publication of advice letters on a company's website. Cal Water will publish this advice letter on its website.

## **Response or Protest**

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or



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(6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Division of Water and Audits within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:

Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform the Division of Water and Audits, within the 20 day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

The advice letter process does not provide for any responses, protests or comments, except for the utility's reply, after the 20 day comment period.

Replies: The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Each reply must be received by the Division of Water and Audits within 5 business days after the end of the protest period, and shall be served on the same day to the person who filed the protest or response.
