### CALIFORNIA WATER SERVICE COMPANY (U 60 W)

### Summary

On December 12, 2014, Cal Water filed Advice Letter 2153 to amortize several of Cal Water's balancing and memorandum accounts. There was an error in the calculation of the Pension Cost Balancing Account amortization, and the General District Balancing Account amortizations did not include complete balances. Cal Water is filing this supplement to correct these two items. Cal Water requests that this advice letter retain the Tier 2 filing status and maintain the same effective date of January 29, 2015.

### Background

The purpose of AL 2153 was to amortize amounts in the following balancing and memorandum accounts as authorized Decision (D.)14-08-011, the Commission's decision resolving Cal Water's 2012 General Rate Case:

The Commission resolved Cal Water’s 2012 General Rate Case (GRC) in D.14-08-011 on August 14, 2014, and authorized the amortization of several balancing and memorandum accounts within 120 days of the decision. In Ordering Paragraph (OP) 1, D.14-08-011 adopts the Settlement Agreement in the GRC proceeding as provided in Exhibit A to the decision. This advice letter requests amortization of five of those accounts, and the elimination of four preliminary statements, as authorized in the following ordering paragraphs in D.14-08-011:

### Ordering Paragraph 20

*Within 120 days of the adoption of this decision, CWS is authorized to file Tier 1 Advice Letters to amortize the balances in the following existing accounts identified in the attached Settlement Agreement:*

- *Conservation Expense Balancing Account (Preliminary Statement Z1);*
- *Pension Cost Balancing Account (Preliminary Statement AA1); and*
- *The American Job Creation Act True-Up Mechanism (no preliminary statement).*

*The balance in each account shall be amortized in accordance with Commission Standard Practice U-27-W.*



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### Ordering Paragraph 22

*California Water Service Company is authorized to transfer the residual balances in the following balancing and memorandum accounts to the relevant General District Balancing Accounts (District BA), close the accounts, and eliminate the preliminary statements for:*

- *Cost of Capital Interim Rate Memo Account (Preliminary Statement AH);*
- *Temporary Interest Rate Balancing Account (Preliminary Statement R);*
- *Water Conservation Expense Memo Account (Preliminary Statement L);*
- *Water Conservation Balancing Account (Preliminary Statement N); and*
- *The Incremental Cost Balancing Accounts (no preliminary statement).*

*Within 120 days of the adoption of this decision, CWS is authorized to file a Tier 1 Advice Letter to amortize the aggregate amounts in the District BA in accordance with Commission Standard Practice U-27-W, and to eliminate the preliminary statements in accordance with the Settlement Agreement attached to this decision as Exhibit A.*

### Discussion

#### **(1) Pension Cost Balancing Account (“PCBA1,” Preliminary Statement AA1)**

The Commission authorized creation of the PCBA1 in D.12-10-017 to track the difference between actual and authorized pension costs for 2011-2013. As indicated in the Settlement Agreement on page 45, ORA verified the balance in this account as a receivable of \$1,673,629 as of August 31, 2012.

The balance in the PCBA1 as of December 31, 2013 is a receivable of \$3,007,305, which has been allocated across all regulated ratemaking areas based upon adopted payroll expenses for 2011-2013. The balances in all areas are below 5% of the last adopted revenue requirement, so the amortization period for all districts is 12 months. In addition, the surcharge is calculated as a fixed amount per customer because, as a general matter, the employee costs tracked in this account are incurred regardless of variations in water sales.

The fixed surcharges identified below will be applied to all customers on a monthly basis for a 12-month period.



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In Advice Letter 2153, Cal Water inadvertently miscalculated the allocation to the Marysville District that distorts the allocation to the rest of the districts. In this supplemental filing, Cal Water made the appropriate corrections and thoroughly reviewed the results. The table below depicts the revised surcharges for the Pension Cost Balancing Account.

## (2) General District Balancing Accounts (“Dist BAs,” Preliminary Statement AO”)

The purpose for creating a balancing account for each ratemaking area (referenced generally as “districts”) in which miscellaneous credits and debits can be tracked was described in the Settlement Agreement on page 36 as follows:



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*Cal Water requests authority to establish district-specific general balancing accounts because, currently, there is no mechanism for Cal Water to close out small balances that remain from memo and balancing accounts that have been over- or under-amortized. For Cal Water to implement small surcredits and surcharges to eliminate these balances, the administrative burden to Cal Water and the Commission and the confusion to customers of another surcharge/surcredit outweigh the minor benefits of closing out the accounts.*

In OP 22 of D.14-08-011, amortization of the General District Balancing Accounts, into which the residual balances of the following balancing and memorandum accounts have been transferred:

- Cost of Capital Interim Rate Memo Account (Preliminary Statement AH);
- Temporary Interest Rate Balancing Account (Preliminary Statement R);
- Water Conservation Expense Memo Account (Preliminary Statement L);
- Water Conservation Balancing Account (Preliminary Statement N); and
- The Incremental Cost Balancing Accounts (no preliminary statement).

The district-specific balances vary, however they are all less than 5% of the last adopted revenue requirement, so the amortization periods are all 12 months. Due to the small amounts of the credits, they are being provided as fixed monthly amounts to all customers. For surcharges, metered customers will receive a usage-based (per Ccf) surcharge, and flat-rate customers will receive a fixed monthly surcharge.

The balances for the Temporary Interest Rate Balancing Account (“TIRBA”) and the Cost of Capital Interim Rate Memo Account (“COC”) used in AL 2153, which were \$30,544 and \$42,827 respectively, were snapshots from early 2013 when refunds for those accounts were still being provided to customers. This **Supplement to AL 2153** reflects the final post-amortization balances for those accounts, the net of which is \$42,292 for TIRBA and \$74,003 for COC. (There were over-collections and under-collections depending on the district.)

The table below depicts the revised amounts and the new calculated surcharge and credits.

## Proposed Tariff Sheets

In AL 2153, Cal Water anticipated filing more advice letters to comply with Commission orders from the 2012 GRC Decision (D.14-08-011) for tariff modifications effective before January 29, 2015, and therefore did not include sheet numbers on the submitted tariff pages. This Supplement to AL 2153 includes tariff pages with sheet numbers reflecting the requested effective date of January 29, 2015.

## Requested Tier Date

While OP 20 authorized amortization of the PCBA1 and the AJCA accounts via a Tier 1 advice letter, Cal Water is requesting authorization to approve amortization of the accounts via a Tier 2 advice letter. Combining amortization of these accounts with amortization of the HomeServe and LIRA MA (partial) accounts, which D.14-08-011 states must be done via a Tier 2 advice letter, would be more administratively efficient. It would allow disposition of all the identified balancing and memorandum accounts in the same informal filing. Cal Water continues to have numerous parties on its advice letter service lists that require hard copy service, so it would also decrease the amount of paper needed for the filing.



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### **Requested Effective Date**

Pursuant to the ordering paragraphs of D.14-08-011 cited above, these tariff changes are being requested via a Tier 1 advice letter. This is also consistent with GO 96-B, Water Industry Rule 7.3.1(3), which provides that an advice letter for actions in compliance with a mandatory resolution may be Tier 1.

Pursuant to GO 96-B, General Rule 7.3.1, a Tier 1 advice letter may be effective immediately, subject to disposition by the Commission. Cal Water requests that this advice letter be effective on January 29, 2015.

### **Notice**

*Customer Notice* – Pursuant to General Rule 4.2 (Customer Notices) and Water Industry Rule 7.3.1 (Tier 1) of General Order 96-B, this advice letter does not require customer notice.

*Service Lists* – In accordance with General Order 96-B, General Rule 4.3 and 7.2 and Water Industry Rule 4.1, a copy of this Supplement will be mailed or electronically transmitted on **January 22, 2015** to competing and adjacent utilities and other utilities or interested parties having requested such notification.

### **Response or Protest**

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest. A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must



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be received by the Division of Water and Audits within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The advice letter process does not provide for any responses, protests, or comments after the 20-day comment period, except for the utility's reply. Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform the Division of Water and Audits, within the 20 day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

### **Replies**

The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Each reply must be received by the Division of Water and Audits within 5 business days after the end of the protest period, and shall be served on the same day to the person who filed the protest or response.
