To the California Public Utilities Commission:

California Water Service Company (“Cal Water”) respectfully submits this Tier 1 advice letter to implement the following changes in its Tariff Schedule No. AS. This change is applicable to all Class A districts, as well as Grand Oaks.

**Summary**

This supplemental Advice Letter is made in compliance with Resolution W-5183 as it reflects the authorized surcharges in Ordering Paragraph 1 and concurrently updates Cal Water’s effective Schedule AS.

**Background**

- January 17, 2014 – Governor of State of California declared State of Emergency in California due to severe drought conditions
- April 1, 2014 – In Advice Letter 2124, Cal Water requested authority to add Preliminary Statement AL, titled “Drought Memorandum Account (“DRMA”)” to its tariff to track incremental costs related to implementing the requirements of Rule 14 and Schedule 14.1. The Commission approved AL 2124 on April 28, 2014, with an effective date of May 1, 2014.
- April 25, 2014 – Governor of State of California issued an Executive Order to strengthen the State’s ability to manage water and habitat effectively in drought conditions, and call on all Californians to redouble their efforts to conserve water.
- May 5, 2015 – the SWRCB issued an Emergency Regulation due to continuing drought conditions with specific water use reductions, by service area, and prohibitions on how end-use customers can use potable water to achieve a statewide 25% reduction in usage as compared with the amount used in 2013 (through February 2016).



- June 1, 2015 – Through Tariff Schedule 14.1, Cal Water implemented individual customer water budgets, with drought surcharges applied to overages, and individual water banking.
- November 13, 2015 – Governor of the State of California issued another Executive Order that directed the Water Board to, if drought conditions persist through January 2016, extend until October 31, 2016 restrictions to achieve a statewide reduction in potable usage.
- On February 2, 2016 – Water Board adopted an extended and revised Emergency Regulation due to continuing drought conditions.
- May 18, 2016 – Water Board approved updated Emergency Regulation that extends emergency regulation through January 2017 with specific modifications, the most significant of these being the creation of a self-certification process for all utilities to identify required reductions based on supply need for a 3 year period.
- July 15, 2016 – In Advice Letter 2225, Cal Water requested elimination of Drought Surcharges throughout its regulated areas beginning July 29, 2016.
- October 12, 2016 – In Advice Letter 2226-A, Cal Water requested authority to amortize net expenses of \$2,945,166 associated with drought activities in 2014-2015 tracked in the Drought Memorandum Account (“DRMA”) through district-specific DRMA surcharges.
- December 15, 2016 – The Commission adopted Resolution W-5122 approving Cal Water’s proposed DRMA surcharges effective January 1, 2017.
- December 30, 2016 – Cal Water filed Advice Letter 2226-B to implement the district-specific DRMA surcharges for a period of 12 months.
- March 30, 2018 – Cal Water filed Advice Letter 2301 to request authority to amortize expenses from 2016-2017 tracked in the DRMA in the amount of \$3,639,658.
- January 10, 2019 – CPUC issues Resolution W-5183 which grants Cal Water the authority to recover \$3,639,658 of authorized revenues for the amounts spent in the DRMA through the twelve month surcharge that was filed in Advice Letter 2301.

### **Authorization**

Cal Water files this request as a Tier 1 advice letter pursuant to General Order 96-B, Water Industry Rule 7.3.1(3), which addresses compliance with a resolution a mandatory statute, decision, or resolution.

### **Requested Implementation Date**

Cal Water proposes that the surcharges in this advice letter be implemented on **April 15, 2019**.<sup>1</sup>

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<sup>1</sup> Consistent with customers’ requests to have fewer rate changes, Cal Water proposes to implement this and other upcoming rate changes (supplements that will be filed for Advice Letters 2325-A, 2326, 2327, and 2328) simultaneously on April 15, 2019.

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. When submitting a response or protest, please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest. A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. Cities and counties requiring Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform the Water Division within the 20-day protest period so a late-filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

The advice letter process does not provide for any responses, protests or comments, except for the utility's reply, after the 20-day comment period.

**Replies:** The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Each reply must be received by the Water Division within 5 business days after the end of the protest period and shall be served on the same day to the person who filed the protest or response.
