Advice Letter No. 2341

To the California Public Utilities Commission:

California Water Service Company (“Cal Water”) respectfully submits this Tier 1 advice letter requesting authority to make the following changes in the tariff schedules applicable to all Class A districts (excludes Grand Oaks).

Summary

This Tier 1 advice letter requests authority to amortize the full balance in the Cost of Capital Memorandum Account (“CoC MA”), and part of the balance in the 2018 Tax Accounting Memorandum Account (“TAMA”), as a fixed, 12-month credit.

The credits reflect revenue decreases stemming from two federal tax law changes adopted in the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act (“TCJA”) and from the Commission’s reduction of Cal Water’s rate of return from 7.94% to 7.48% adopted in D.18-03-035, for the period of January 1 – June 30, 2018. (Rates were updated to reflect these changes starting July 1, 2018.)

Background

In December 2017, the federal “Tax Cuts and Jobs Act” (“TCJA”) lowered the corporate tax rate from 35% to 21%, eliminated the Domestic Production Activities Deduction (“DPAD”),¹ and adopted other changes to federal tax laws. On December 29, 2017, Cal Water filed AL 2292 to open a new memorandum account (the “2018 Tax Accounting Memo Account”) to capture the impacts of the TCJA on rates beginning January 1, 2018.

¹ The TCJA also repealed the Section 199 Domestic Production Activities Deduction (“DPAD”), which had provided a tax deduction for income from “qualified production activities” in the U.S., including activities related to water production. In the Net-to-Gross calculations in Cal Water’s workpapers, this deduction has historically been reflected as the line item called the “American Jobs Creation Act.” In the workpapers for this advice letter, the value for that line item is now 0%.



In March 2018, the Commission approved a decrease in Cal Water's rate of return from 7.94% to 7.48% in D.18-03-035. On March 30, 2018, Cal Water filed AL 2300 to open a new memorandum account (the "Cost of Capital Memo Account") to capture the impacts of the Commission's decision, D.18-03-035, on rates beginning January 1, 2018.

Cal Water filed AL 2310 to lower rates in all of its Class A ratemaking areas, effective July 1, 2018, to reflect both the decrease in the corporate tax rate from 35% to 21%, the elimination of the DPAD, and the decrease in Cal Water's rate of return from 7.94% to 7.48%.

Discussion

In this advice letter, Cal Water requests authority to apply a 12-month fixed monthly surcredit to customer bills of all Class A ratemaking areas to reflect:

- (1) The revenue tracked in the Cost of Capital Memo Account (Preliminary Statement AW) associated with the decrease in the rate of return, adopted in D.18-03-035, for the period of January 1, 2018 – June 30, 2018.
- (2) The revenue tracked in the 2018 Tax Accounting Memo Account (Preliminary Statement AV) associated with the decrease in the federal corporate tax rate, and the elimination of the DPAD, for the period of January 1, 2018 – June 30, 2018.

This amortization will address the entire balance in the Cost of Capital Memo Account. For the 2018 Tax Accounting Memo Account, however, this request does not address balances associated with other federal tax law changes adopted in the TCJA, except those described above.

Authorization

Cal Water files this request as a Tier 1 advice letter pursuant to General Order 96-B.

Requested Effective Date

Cal Water proposes that this advice letter become effective on **April 15, 2019**.

Notice

Customer Notice: The rate decreases requested in this advice letter do not require notice pursuant to General Order 96-B, General Rule 4.2 and Water Industry Rule 7.3.1. The revenue increases reflected in the calculations were properly requested and noticed in previous advice letters.

Service List: In accordance with General Order 96-B, General Rules 4.3 and 7.2, and Water Industry Rule 4.1, a copy of this advice letter will be mailed or electronically transmitted on **April 11, 2019** to competing and adjacent utilities and other utilities or interested parties having requested such notification.



Response or Protest

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. When submitting a response or protest, please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest. A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

The advice letter process does not provide for any responses, protests or comments, except for the utility's reply, after the 20-day comment period.
