AL. Drought Memorandum Account (DRMA)

1. Purpose: The purpose of the Drought Memorandum Account (DRMA) is to track costs and penalties associated with the implementation of Rule 14.1 and Schedule 14.1 consistent with Resolution W-4976 in which the Commission adopted Drought Procedures.
2. Applicability: The DRMA will track the following item:
  - a. Incremental operating and administrative costs associated with implementing voluntary conservation measures under Rule 14.1, as modified by Advice Letter 2123, submitted on April 1, 2014;
  - b. Incremental operating and administrative costs associated with implementing mandatory rationing measures under Schedule 14.1, if Cal Water seeks such implementation consistent with the Commission's requirements;
  - c. Monies paid by customers for fines, penalties, or other compliance measures associated with water use violations; and
  - d. Penalties paid by Cal Water to its water wholesalers.
3. Disposition: Charges made to the Drought Memorandum Account are subject to a reasonableness review in a General Rate Case, or in an appropriate advice letter filing consistent with General Order 96-B and Standard Practices.
