California Water Service Company ("Cal Water") respectfully submits this Tier 2 advice letter to update the service area map for the Livermore district.

Summary

Cal Water requests modifications to its Visalia service area boundary and its service area map.

Background

Cal Water most recently filed an update to its Visalia service area map on October 18, 2016 in advice letter 2223. Now, Cal Water will be extending service to the contiguous areas mark on the proposed map. These parcels contain residential customers that will be served by Cal Water.

Discussion

The service area map submitted in this advice letter contains two extension of the current service area boundary.

The first extension will be adjacent to the current service area boundary and include 68 domestic services, three irrigation services and 9 fire hydrants. A majority of the development is slated to be single family and multi-residential units. This area is labeled as (1) on the proposed service area map.

The second extension will be adjacent to Visalia's Mullen system. The current owner uses this parcel for agricultural reasons but will soon construct a single family residence that will require water service from Cal Water. This area is labeled as (2) on the proposed service area map.



In lieu of the Water Supply and Certification Questionnaires (WSQs), Cal Water is providing excerpts from Visalia 2015 Urban Water Management Plan. In doing so, Cal Water is able to provide proof that it, "Already has a water supply adequate to serve areas or a plan to obtain such supply," as required by GO 96-B, Rule 8.1.

The UWMP was adopted in June 2016 and submitted to the California Department of Water Resources in July 2016.

Chapter 3 of the UWMP provides a description of the system, including a discussion on the population. Chapter 4 focuses on system water use with a breakdown of actual water demand by use type in Table 4-1 as well as projections through 2040 for water demand in Table 4-2 (by use type) and Table 4-3 (total). Meanwhile, Table 4-4 provides a water loss summary from the most recent 12-month period available.

Chapter 6 discusses system supplies and provides a summary of water supplies in Table 6-8 (actual) as well as projected water supplies in Table 6-9.

Taken in combination, Table 4-1 and Table 6-8 demonstrate that developments added to the district's service area have had sufficient water supplied.

Taken in combination, Table 4-2 (or Table 4-3) and Table 6-9 demonstrate that projected growth will have sufficient water supplied.

Cal Water will provide a copy of the UWMP to the Water Division upon request.

Authority

Cal Water submits this as a Tier 2 advice letter according to General Order 96-B, Water Industry Rule 7.3.2(8).

Requested Effective Date

Cal Water requests that the attached tariffs in this Tier 2 advice letter become effective on November 26, 2018.

Notice

In accordance with General Order 96-B, General Rule 4.3 and 7.2 and Water Industry Rules 4.1 and 4.2, a copy of this advice letter has been mailed or electronically transmitted on October 26, 2018 to the service list for this district, including parties who have requested copies when revisions are made to this district's service area map.



Response or Protest

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. When submitting a response or protest, please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest. A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. Cities and counties requiring Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform the Division of Water and Audits within the 20-day protest period so a late-filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.



The advice letter process does not provide for any responses, protests or comments, except for the utility's reply, after the 20-day comment period.

<u>Replies</u>: The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Each reply must be received by the Division of Water and Audits within 5 business days after the end of the protest period and shall be served on the same day to the person who filed the protest or response. 
