RE: Disposition of California Water Service Advice Letters 2418 & 2424

Dear Ms. Wales:

Please be advised that the Water Division is accepting California Water Service's (Cal Water) Advice Letter (AL) 2418 submitted on September 17, 2021 and AL 2424 submitted on September 30, 2021. AL 2418 is requesting approval of an Emergency Water Service Agreement (Agreement) between Cal Water's Chico District and Butte County, and AL 2424 is requesting approval of an Agreement between Cal Water's Bakersfield District and Califia Farms.

The Agreement with Butte County has been in effect since September 3, 2021 and will continue until January 31, 2022 and may be extended for two additional successive one-year terms with the written agreement of Cal Water and Butte County. The Agreement with Califia Farms was in effect from September 29 to October 6, 2021. Pursuant to both Agreements, Butte County and Califia Farms have had access to withdraw water from designated Cal Water hydrants and are being billed the current rates for non-residential metered service in the Chico and Bakersfield Districts respectively.

All revenues received from the Agreements are being tracked by Cal Water and will be for the benefit of the ratepayers. Cal Water should record the quantity revenues in the Water Revenue Adjustment Mechanism and Modified Cost Balancing Account (WRAM/MCBA). For the service charge revenues and any other revenues not booked in the WRAM/MCBA, Water Division is directing Cal Water to record these revenues in Cal Water's current Drought Memo Account.<sup>1</sup>


Commission approval for AL 2418 and AL 2424 is not required, because the emergency water service agreements do not deviate from existing tariffs and will not adversely impact existing customers.

**Discussion**

Cal Water requests approval of the attached list of Contracts and Deviations for Califia Farms, LLC near Cal Water's Bakersfield District service area. Califia Farms is not a customer of Cal Water. Cal Water and Califia Farms have entered into an Agreement for Emergency Water Service ("Agreement") for the provision of emergency water because they do not currently have a reliable water well due to needed repairs.

This advice letter is submitted as a Tier 2 filing consistent with General Order 96-B, Water Industry Rules 8.3 and 7.3.2(2). Due to the emergency, Califia Farms began taking water consistent with the spirit of the contract on the evening of September 28, 2021. Therefore, Cal Water requests approval of this advice letter effective immediately, as allowed under Water Industry Rule 7.2(2).

**Requested Effective Date**

Cal Water is submitting this as a **Tier 2** advice letter and requests that approval of this Agreement be considered effective immediately.

- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.)

## **ATTACHMENT 1**

## AGREEMENT FOR EMERGENCY WATER SERVICE

THIS AGREEMENT is made on Sept 29, 2021, by and between Califia Farms, LLC and CALIFORNIA WATER SERVICE COMPANY, a California corporation (“**Cal Water**”) (together, “**Parties**”).

### RECITALS

- A. Califia Farms, LLC is a beverage manufacturer located in Kern County, CA
- B. Cal Water is a public utility company regulated by the California Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) that provides water services throughout California, including in and around the City of Bakersfield, Kern County, California.
- C. Califia Farms, LLC near Cal Water’s Bakersfield District service area who are not customers of Cal Water, and who do not currently have a reliable water well due to needed repairs.
- D. Califia Farms, LLC desires to receive, and Cal Water agrees to provide, emergency water service pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement to assist with emergency water for a limited time period.
- E. Cal Water enters into this Agreement subject to its currently approved tariffs and Commission rules and regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the provisions herein contained, it is agreed as follows:

- 1. Recitals. The above Recitals are incorporated into this Agreement as if fully set forth herein.
- 2. Definitions.
  - a. “Califia Farms, LLC” means the employees, agents, and contractors of Califia Farms, LLC.
- 3. Emergency Water Service.
  - a. Access: Cal Water hereby grants permission to Califia Farms, LLC to access designated hydrants in Cal Water’s Bakersfield District in order to withdraw water pursuant to this Agreement. Unless otherwise specified in the Agreement, all terms and conditions of service are subject to Cal Water’s tariffs.

b. Meters. Cal Water shall provide a meter with backflow devices to Califia Farms, LLC for the purpose of measuring the volume of water withdrawn by Califia Farms, LLC. Califia Farms, LLC agrees to connect the meters to only the designated hydrant, absent advance written agreement from Cal Water to use a non-designated hydrant.

c. Backflow Prevention. Califia Farms, LLC shall withdraw water from a designated hydrant only if a backflow prevention device (or other method approved in writing by Cal Water) is in place to prevent the backflow of water into Cal Water's system.

d. Designated Hydrants. Cal Water and Califia Farms, LLC will meet and select the designated hydrants for Califia Farms, LLC for use in the areas agreed to by Cal Water. The designated hydrant will be shown on a map or identified by street address in writing, which is incorporated by reference into this Agreement.

4. Limitations.

a. Califia Farms, LLC shall only provide water to their plant within the Kern Groundwater Sub-basin DWR 5-022.14 as defined in the California Department of Water Resources (DWR) Groundwater Bulletin 118, as shown on **Appendix B** attached hereto. Califia Farms, LLC must comply with the State Water Resources Control Board's restrictions on water use and Cal Water's Tariff Rule 14.1. Califia Farms, LLC is prohibited from reselling water obtained under this Agreement pursuant to Cal Water's tariffs.

b. Califia Farms, LLC agrees to the maximum monthly limitations of water service under this Agreement, as specified in **Appendix A**, which may be modified by mutual written agreement of the Parties or by the Commission.

c. Only Califia Farms, LLC or their contractor shall withdraw water from Cal Water's designated hydrant under this Agreement.

d. If the Commission determines that terms or conditions of this Agreement are not reasonable or are not in the public interest, the Agreement shall terminate at a time mutually agreed-upon by the Parties, but in no event later than **30 days** after the Commission's determination. In such case, Califia Farms, LLC shall remit payment under the terms of this Agreement for any water withdrawn prior to termination.

5. No Warranties. Cal Water does not warrant the quality of water after it is withdrawn from its hydrants by Califia Farms, LLC or their contractor; in particular, Cal Water makes no representation that the water obtained under this Agreement meets the state's health and safety requirements for safe drinking water. **THE WATER IS PROVIDED "AS IS" WITHOUT WARRANTY OF ANY KIND, EITHER EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE IMPLIED**

WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.

6. Billing and Compensation.

a. Cal Water shall bill Califia Farms, LLC monthly for all water obtained under this Agreement.

b. The effective tariff rates for non-residential metered service in the Bakersfield District shall apply to water withdrawn under this Agreement, with the amount of the fixed monthly service charge determined by the size of the requested meter. Current tariffs can be obtained from the Cal Water website at:

c. Before commencing water withdrawals, Califia Farms, LLC will deposit with Cal Water the replacement cost of meters and backflow devices (see Appendix A). The deposit will be refunded to Califia Farms, LLC upon return of the meter and backflow device, less any repair or replacement costs, at the termination of the Agreement.

7. Term and Termination.

a. This Agreement shall continue in effect until 10/06/2021, or 1 month from the effective date of this Agreement, whichever is earlier. The term of this Agreement may be extended by mutual agreement of the Parties for two additional successive one-year terms. Either Party may terminate this Agreement, with or without cause, by providing at least **ninety (30) days** advance written notice to the other.

b. Notwithstanding the above notice for termination, if the Commission or Cal Water, in its sole discretion, determines that continuing with the Agreement negatively impacts Cal Water's operations or customers who are situated within Cal Water's Commission-approved service area (including a determination that there is excessive or inappropriate use of water obtained under this Agreement), Califia Farms, LLC shall be notified, and the Parties shall develop a timetable and process (such as phasing in a decrease of the maximum withdrawal amounts) to ensure termination of the Agreement within a reasonable time not to exceed **thirty (15) days**.

8. Notice. Any notice required or given under this Agreement must be in writing, and may be given either personally, by certified mail, by overnight mail, or by electronic mail. If personally delivered, a notice shall be deemed to have been given and received when delivered to the party to whom it is addressed. If given by certified mail or overnight carrier, the same shall be deemed to have been given and received on the first to occur of (a) actual receipt by any of the addressees designated below as the party to whom notices are to be sent, or (b) **five (5) days** after a letter containing such notice, properly addressed, with postage prepaid, is deposited in the United States mail or with

the overnight carrier. Such notices or communications shall be given to the parties at their addresses set forth below:

Any party from time to time, by notice to the other party, given as set forth above, may change its address for purpose of receipt of any such notice.

9. Indemnity. Califia Farms, LLC shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless Cal Water and its directors, officers, employees, and agents from and against all third party claims, damages, losses, liabilities, expenses, and attorney's fees (collectively "Claims") to the extent arising from a negligent act or omission or intentional misconduct Califia Farms, LLC, its employees, agents, or contractors in accessing a hydrant or the delivery of emergency water from a hydrant, including, but not limited to, Claims for:

a. Bodily injury including, but not limited to, sickness or disease, emotional injury or death to persons, the public, End Users, employees or agents of Califia Farms, LLC or any contractor;

b. Damage to real or personal property of anyone, including loss of use thereof; and

c. Water shortages, delays, curtailment, interruption, or service termination to any End User of water delivered by Califia Farms, LLC under this Agreement.

10. Entire Agreement; Modification. This Agreement contains the entire agreement between the parties with respect to the subject matter of this Agreement and supersedes all prior or contemporaneous agreement and understandings (whether written or oral) of the parties. This Agreement cannot be modified in any manner except by an instrument in writing executed by the duly authorized representatives of the parties.

11. Severability. If any term or provision of this Agreement is, to any extent, held invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this Agreement shall not be affected.
12. Waivers. Any waiver of a breach of any covenant or condition in this Agreement is not to be deemed a waiver of any other covenant or condition in this Agreement and no waiver is valid unless in writing and executed by the duly authorized representative of the waiving party. An extension of time for performance of any obligation or act is not to be deemed an extension of the time for performance of any other obligation or act.
13. Successors. This Agreement inures to the benefit of and is binding upon the parties to this Agreement and their respective heirs, successors, and assigns.
14. Governing Law. This Agreement is to be governed by and construed in accordance with California law.
15. Insurance. Califia Farms, LLC shall secure or cause its contractors to secure and maintain the insurance described below throughout the term of this Agreement. Califia Farms, LLC shall furnish to Cal Water an endorsement evidencing that Cal Water is an additional insured and certificates evidencing such insurance coverages prior to water service, and upon request of Cal Water.

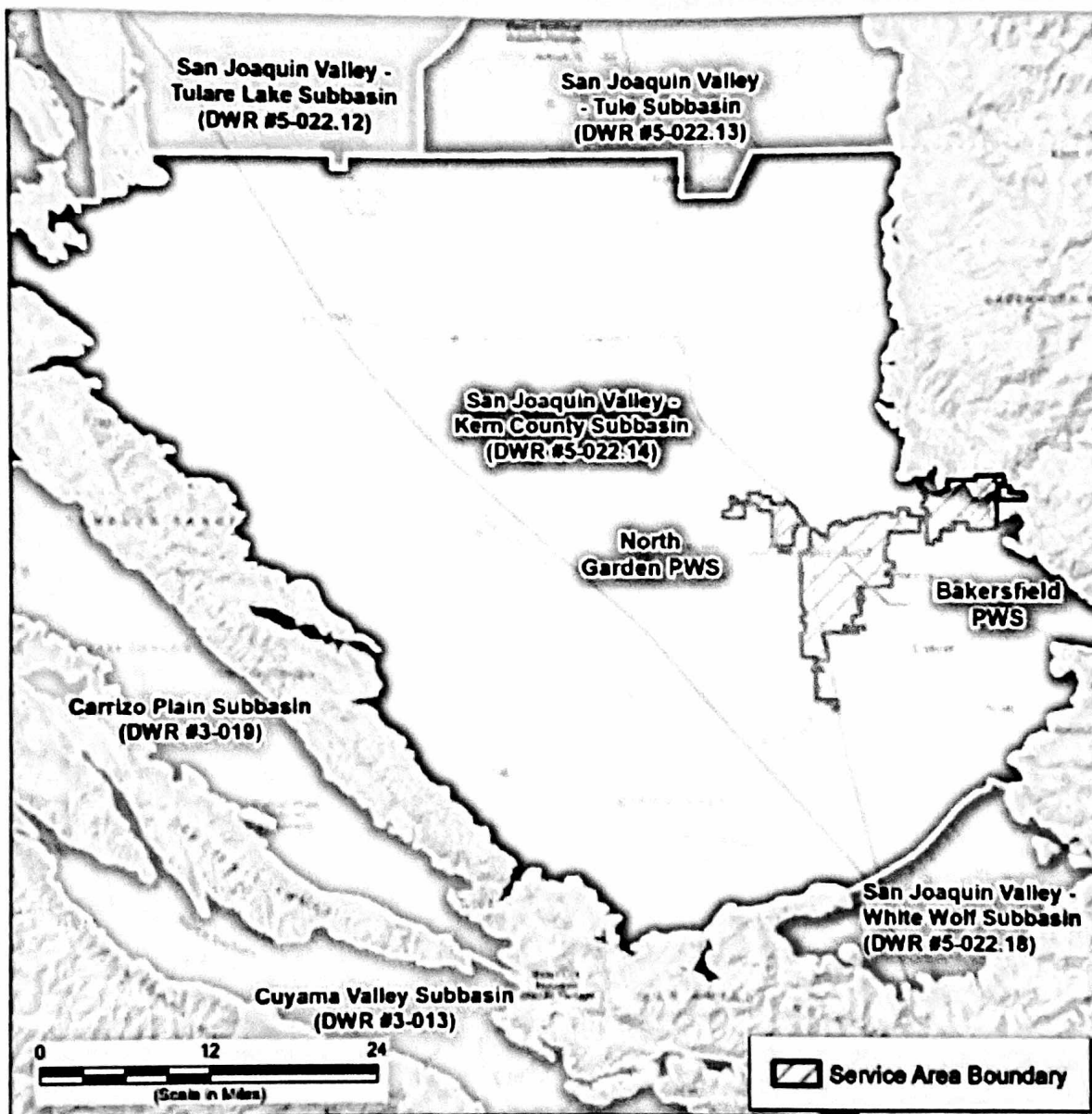
