Advice Letter No. 2429-A

To the California Public Utilities Commission:

California Water Service Company ("Cal Water") respectfully submits this Tier 2 advice letter requesting authority to make the following changes to tariffs applicable to Cal Water's Chico District.

Please note that, consistent with the Commission's guidelines during the COVID-19 pandemic, this advice letter is only being distributed electronically to the Water Division and the attached service lists.

<u>Summary</u>

In Advice Letter 2410, Cal Water requested modifications to the service area boundary and map for the Chico District to reflect two service area extensions into contiguous areas. This supplement to AL 2410 corrects and adds six more service additions to the requested service area map extension.

Discussion

Cal Water's current service area map for Chico was approved in Advice Letter 2385 (filed on July 23, 2020). In this filing, Cal Water is requesting to extend service into contiguous areas marked in yellow on the proposed map. Tie-ins for these developments are anticipated to serve about 70 new residential services in Q1 of 2022. Some of these developments have already been constructed and are ready for tie-in.

In lieu of the Water Supply and Certification Questionnaires (WSQs), Cal Water is providing excerpts from Chico's 2020 Urban Water Management Plan (UWMP). In doing so, Cal Water is able to provide proof that it "already has a water supply adequate to serve the areas or a plan to obtain such a supply" as required by GO 96-B, Rule 8.1. The UWMP was adopted in June 2021 and



submitted to the California Department of Water Resources in July 2021. The next UWMP will be available sometime in 2026, as the study is completed on a five-year cycle.

- Chapter 3 of the UWMP provides a description of the system, including a discussion on the population. Chapter 4 focuses on system water use with a breakdown of actual water demand by use type in Table 4-1 as well as projections through 2045 for water demand in Table 4-2 (by use type) and Table 4-3 (total). Meanwhile, Table 4-4 provides a water loss summary from the most recent 12-month period available.
- Chapter 6 discusses system supplies and provides a summary of actual water supplies in **Table 6-8** as well as projected water supplies in **Table 6-9**.

Taken in combination, Table 4-1 and Table 6-8 demonstrate that developments added to the district's service area have had sufficient water supplied.

Taken in combination, Table 4-2 (and Table 4-3) and Table 6-9 demonstrate that projected growth will have sufficient water supplied.

Authority

Cal Water submits this as a **Tier 2** advice letter according to General Order 96-B, Water Industry Rule 7.3.2 (8) and Rule 8.1.

Requested Effective Date

Cal Water requests that the attached tariffs in this Tier 2 advice letter become effective on **January 27, 2022**.

Notice

Response or Protest

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;



- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest. A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The advice letter process does not provide for any responses, protests or comments, except for the utility's reply, after the 20-day comment period. Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform the Water Division, within the 20-day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

Replies

The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Each reply must be received by the Water Division within 5 business days after the end of the protest period, and shall be served on the same day to the person who filed the protest or response. If you have not received a reply to your protest within 10 business days, contact California Water Service Company at 408-367-8200.


