## **Advice Letter No. 2502**

### **CALIFORNIA WATER SERVICE COMPANY (U-60-W)**

To The Public Utilities Commission of the State of California:

California Water Service Company ("Cal Water") hereby respectfully requests authority to update the following tariff applicable to all regulated Class A ratemaking areas<sup>1</sup> (excludes the Grand Oaks District) to reflect a new Rate of Return ("ROR") of 7.46%. ***Please note that this advice letter will only be distributed electronically.***

### **Summary**

On November 8, 2023, the Commission approved AL 2495, in which Cal Water gave notice that the Water Cost of Capital Mechanism ("WCCM") had triggered for its Class A ratemaking areas, resulting in an increase in Cal Water's ROR from 7.08% to 7.46%, effective January 1, 2024.

In this advice letter, Cal Water requests authority to implement new rates based on the new ROR of 7.46% on January 1, 2024.

### **Background**

In D.23-06-025, the Commission adopted a new cost of capital for Cal Water and retained the WCCM, which automatically adjusts the cost of capital when fluctuations in capital markets occur between cost of capital applications.

In AL 2485, Cal Water received approval to modify Preliminary Statement S to update the terms of the WCCM and provided notice that the WCCM had been triggered for the customer rates Cal Water planned to implement on July 31, 2023. With the WCCM triggered using 2022 as the base year, the result is a higher return on equity of 9.57%, with no change in the cost of debt at 4.23%.

In AL 2495, Cal Water notified the Commission that the WCCM had again triggered, resulting in a higher return on equity of 10.27% (a 70-basis point increase) with no change in the cost of debt at 4.23%. This amounts to an ROR increase from 7.08% to 7.46%, starting January 1, 2024.

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<sup>1</sup> The one exception is that, for Travis, at a later time Cal Water will file a separate advice letter that incorporates all the changes upcoming for Travis and submit a final tariff.



## Discussion

The Commission approved a new cost of capital for Cal Water in D.23-06-025. As discussed in AL 2495, the WCCM has been triggered twice, resulting in a new adopted cost of capital as shown in Figure 1, below.

This change impacts all of Cal Water’s Class A ratemaking areas.<sup>2</sup> The new ROR of 7.46% is a 38-basis-point increase from the 7.08% ROR upon which Cal Water’s current rates are based. New customer rates reflecting the new ROR result in a revenue increase of approximately \$10 million dollars<sup>3</sup> from last adopted revenues.

Water Production Offsets. The new rates submitted in this advice letter already reflect the expense offsets relating to water production (purchased water and pump taxes) in several districts, as requested in AL 2501, which resulted in a revenue increase of approximately \$5.1 million.

Rates Reflect Interim Rate Increase. All rates charged since January 1, 2023 are considered “interim” until “final” rates are implemented as a result of a decision in Application (“A.”) 21-07-002 (Cal Water’s 2021 General Rate Case). In AL 2475, the Commission approved an increase in

those interim rates (not an increase in authorized revenue) consisting of the following percentage of each rate component in effect at that time (April 15, 2023): 4% for all ratemaking areas except 1.5% for Marysville, and no increases in Travis, Selma, and Visalia.

The new rates submitted in this advice letter reflect the interim rate increases (if any), but only by the dollar amount approved for each rate element in AL 2475, rather than as a percentage of the current rate element. In particular, rates were calculated based on the new revenue requirement proposed in this advice letter, and then each rate component was increased by the dollar amount approved (for that particular rate component) in AL 2475.

### **Requested Effective Date**

This is a Tier 1 advice letter pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 5 of D.23-06-025, with a requested effective date of **January 1, 2024**.

### **Notice**

*Customer Notice* – This is a Tier 1 advice letter that does not require customer notice, as provided in Water Industry Rule 7.3.1 of General Order 96-B.

### **Response or Protest**

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest. A response or protest must be made in writing and must be received by the Water

Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform the Water Division, within the 20-day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

The advice letter process does not provide for any responses, protests, or comments, except for the utility's reply, after the 20-day comment period.

**Replies:**

The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Each reply must be received by the Water Division within 5 business days after the end of the protest period and shall be served on the same day to the person who filed the protest or response. If you have not received a reply to your protest within 10 business days, contact California Water Service Company at 408-367-8200 and ask for the Rates Department.
