

Advice Letter No. 2504

CALIFORNIA WATER SERVICE COMPANY (U-60-W)

To the California Public Utilities Commission:

California Water Service Company ("Cal Water") respectfully submits this Tier 1 advice letter requesting authority to modify the following tariff sheets for its Travis District. *Please note that this advice letter will only be distributed electronically.*

<u>Summary</u>

This advice letter requests modifications to the tariff for the Travis District to reflect line items for the following updated surcharges and rates, effective January 1, 2024, in order to facilitate the customer's billing process: the Rate Support Fund (RSF) surcharge, the Customer Assistance Program (CAP) surcharge, the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) Utility Fee, and the increase to the authorized Rate of Return ("ROR").

Discussion

Cal Water does not send a water bill to the Travis Air Force Base (TAFB) for payment as it does to customers in other ratemaking areas. Instead, Cal Water requests payment of the total bill – which consists of the flat monthly rate plus applicable surcharges – on a monthly basis through the federal government's online portal.

Cal Water proposes to modify the Travis tariff to reflect the most recently approved amounts for the RSF and CAP surcharges. The RSF surcharge is changing from 0.8317% to 0.6218%, as authorized in Advice Letter 2499. The decrease in the RSF surcharge results in a monthly dollar decrease of \$334.28. The CAP surcharge is changing from 2.459% to 2.690% as approved in Advice Letter 2498, which results in a monthly increase of \$411.13.

Cal Water also proposes to modify the Travis tariff to reflect the change to the CPUC Utility Fee to be set at 0.70% in compliance with Resolution M-4870, which was approved by the Commission on December 14, 2023. The decrease in the CPUC Utility Fee results in a monthly dollar decrease of \$154.08.



Finally, Cal Water proposes to modify the Travis tariff to reflect the increase in Cal Water's rate of return from 7.08% to 7.46%, as requested in Advice Letter 2502.¹ This results in an increase to the flat monthly service charge of \$1,281.68.

All of the above changes will become effective on January 1, 2024. The updated tariff provides the dollar amounts associated with applying each updated surcharge to TAFB's new flat monthly fee. The total increase as a result of all the changes is **\$1,204.45 per month** (0.71%) from the last adopted bill amount, as shown below:

Response or Protest

advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

(1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;

(2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;

(3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;

(4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or

(5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or

(6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest. A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. Cities and counties requiring Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform the Water Division within the 20-day protest period so a late-filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

The advice letter process does not provide for any responses, protests or comments, except for the utility's reply, after the 20-day comment period.

Replies:



The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Each reply must be received by the Water Division within 5 business days after the end of the protest period and shall be served on the same day to the person who filed the protest or response. If you have not received a reply to your protest within 10 business days, contact California Water Service Company at (408) 367-8200 and ask for the Rates Department.
