Advice Letter No. 2539

To the California Public Utilities Commission:

California Water Service Company ("Cal Water") respectfully submits this Tier 1 advice letter ("AL") requesting approval to implement the tariff changes listed below applicable to all Class A service areas except Travis. The Travis rate schedule incorporating the relevant changes will be filed in a separate advice letter. Please note that this advice letter will only be distributed electronically to the Water Division and the attached service lists.

Summary

Cal Water requests authority to implement the attached proposed rates that reflect attrition year increases (as appropriate), revenue adjustments for 2025 sales and services, and the revenue impacts of two previously-filed advice letters – AL 2535 for water production cost offsets ('Pending for Approval') and AL 2536 for rate base offsets ('Pending for approval') filed for used and useful projects previously authorized in Cal Water's 2018 General Rate Case ("GRC") Decision (D.20-12-007) and Cal Water's 2021 GRC Decision (D. 24-03-042).

In ALs 2535 and 2536, which are still under review by the Water Division, Cal Water requested an effective date of January 1, 2025, which coincides with the proposed effective date of this advice letter. Implementing the rate changes in these advice letters at the same time will help avoid customer confusion and frustration.

The tariffs attached to this advice letter accordingly reflect all the revenue, sales, and service changes proposed in the advice letters discussed above for a proposed effective date of January 1, 2025.

Background

On March 7, 2024, the Commission issued D.24-03-042 resolving Cal Water's 2021 GRC. The Commission adopted the following Ordering Paragraphs in D.24-03-042:

2. The Joint Motion of California Water Service Company and the Public Advocates Office to adopt an Amended Partial Settlement Agreement is approved, and the Amended Partial Settlement Agreement between California Water Service Company and the Public Advocates Office at the California Public Utilities Commission (Settlement Agreement) is adopted and

attached to this decision as Appendix 1. The parties are bound by, and the adopted rate recovery is set by, the terms of the complete Settlement Agreement.¹

- 32. We adopt the post-test year ratemaking mechanisms, estimated rates, and forecasted sales for each rate district and rate area for California Water Service Company, as illustrated in Appendices A through Z attached hereto and reflecting all terms of the Settlement Agreement and this decision.
- 33. For escalation year 2025, California Water Service Company shall file Tier 1 advice letters, in conformance with General Order 96-B and Revised Water Rate Case Plan (Decision 05-05-062), proposing new revenue requirements and corresponding revised tariff schedules in each rate district and rate area in this proceeding, and in conformance with the Settlement agreement and adopted estimated rates for each rate area as illustrated in the attached Appendices A through Z. This filing shall be subject to approval by the Commission's Water Division.

Discussion

In this advice letter, Cal Water requests authority to implement new rates that are consistent with D.24-03-042, updating for 2025 escalation increases, adjusting revenue for 2025 sales and services, and incorporating revenue offsets previously filed with the Commission. As referenced in the Summary above, Cal Water is requesting an **effective date** of **January 1, 2025**, **for this advice letter filing**.

A. Summary of Incremental Revenue Adjustments

The Incremental revenue adjustments shown in Table 1 are briefly summarized below. Full descriptions of the incremental revenue adjustments are provided in the following sections.

Column C – Attrition year increases for eligible ratemaking areas ("RMAs")³;

- Column D Revenue adjustments for adopted sales and services consistent with the 2021 GRC Settlement Agreement (all RMAs);
- Column E Revenue offsets for water production requested in AL 2535 (pending approval)
 (8 RMAs); and
- Column F Revenue offsets for used and useful capital projects requested in AL 2536 (still under review by the Water Division) (9 RMAs).

B. Attrition Year Rates for January 1, 2025 (Column C)

As shown in the workpapers for this advice letter, Cal Water calculated the pro-forma rate of return and performed the earnings test for each RMA consistent with Standard Practice U-34-W to determine what, if any, revenue adjustment was appropriate for the 2025 attrition year. The proforma rate of return was calculated using the inflation factors provided by the Public Advocates Office ("Cal Advocates"), with the exception that labor rates are based on Cal Water's current union contract consistent with the 2021 GRC Settlement Agreement.⁴ All RMAs are eligible for a full or partial attrition year increase except for the Kern River Valley ("KRV") District and the Palos Verdes ("PV") Pipeline.⁵ However, Cal Water will file for a revenue decrease for PV Pipeline to reflect a reduction in rate base as authorized in D. 24-03-042⁶ (corrected by D. 24-03-042). Cal Water also adjusted the 2025 pro forma income taxes for the difference in interest deduction used to calculate income taxes. Cal Water's current rate of return (7.46%) includes lower debt ratio (1.97%) than that of the debt ratio (2.57%) included in 2021 GRC adopted rate of return (7.48%). Therefore, income tax adjustments were recalculated for all RMA using lower interest deduction (1.97% versus 2.57%).

C. Sales and Services Update for January 1, 2025 (Column D)

As shown in the 2021 GRC Settlement Agreement, different sales and services were adopted for each year for the 2023-2025 GRC period.⁷ The workpapers reflect the use of the adopted sales and

services data for attrition year 2025 for each RMA, which in most cases resulted in revenue decreases due to lower water production costs.

D. Purchased Water and Pump Tax Offsets for January 1, 2025 (Column E)

In AL 2535, Cal Water requested authorization to adjust revenues associated with increased water production costs (in this case, purchased water and pump taxes) for the Bay Area Region, Bear Gulch, East Los Angeles, Los Altos, Los Angeles County Region, South Bay Region, and Westlake RMAs as applicable. In 2535, Cal Water also requested to decrease revenues associated with water production cost for the Stockton RMA. Since Cal Water requested an effective date of January 1, 2025, for AL 2535, the attached workpapers include these revenue adjustments in the final rates for respective RMAs.

E. Rate Base Offsets for January 1, 2025 (Column F)

In AL 2536, Cal Water has requested approval for revenue increases associated with 28 used and useful capital projects previously authorized by the Commission in D.20-12-007 and D.24-03-042 (corrected by D.24-04-043). Cal Water requested an effective date of January 1, 2025, for AL 2536, which is still under review by the Water Division. As such, the attached workpapers also include these revenue adjustments in the final rates for respective RMAs. If the Water Division's review of AL 2536 continues beyond the 30-day period and to a point where a January 1, 2025, effective date is no longer feasible, Cal Water will file a supplement to this advice letter to adjust rates accordingly.

F. Travis Rate Schedule:

Cal Water's Travis RMA includes a single customer, Travis Air Force Base ("TAFB"). Cal Water does not send a water bill to the TAFB for payment as it does for customers in other ratemaking areas. Instead, Cal Water requests payment of the total bill which consists of the flat monthly rate plus applicable surcharges. Cal Water proposes \$274,896.57 as the new flat monthly rate in this advice letter, however, the applicable surcharges will be submitted in separate subsequent advice letter filings. The final Travis rate schedule will incorporate updates to the monthly flat rate as proposed in this advice letter, the to-be-determined Rate Support Fund (RSF) and Customer Assistance Program (CAP) surcharges, as well as the CPUC Fee.

G. Kern River Valley Rate Design:

As adopted in D.24-03-042 and described above, Cal Water adjusts rates for post-test year sales and services. However, sales in the KRV District have been higher than adopted levels for both 2023 and 2024. Therefore, Cal Water is requesting recalculate 2025 rates using the 2024 proposed sales and services from its 2024 GRC. Doing so will increase the assumed sales from 180,068 to 216,776 ccfs, reducing the general quantity rate for all customers from \$28.6199 to \$23.7735.



H. Typical Bill Impact:

The table below shows the monthly bill impact to typical residential customer for the January 2025 revenue increases including attrition year steps increases, updated sales and services, purchased water/pump tax offsets, and rate base offsets for applicable districts.

Response or Protest

A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest. A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. Cities and counties requiring Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform the Water Division within the 20-day protest period so a late-filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on. The advice letter process does not provide for any responses, protests or comments, except for the utility's reply, after the 20-day comment period.

<u>Replies:</u> The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Each reply must be received by the Water Division within 5 business days after the end of the protest period and shall be served on the same day to the person who filed the protest or response. If you have not received a reply to your protest within 10 business days, contact California Water Service Company at (408) 367-8200 and ask for the Rates Department.
