Water Testing

This summer, Cal Water will test water from a representative number of customers' taps to determine if there is lead or copper in your home's plumbing system.

Participate

Cal Water is seeking customers to take part in the next round of testing at no cost to you. To determine if your home is eligible, Cal Water will call you to do a quick survey about your home's plumbing system.





Be Prepared & Take a Peek

Prior to Cal Water's call, we encourage customers to get to know their plumbing system. The survey questions will ask about the water supply pipes in your home's plumbing system.

Is the Water Supply Pipe Made Out of Copper?

Take a look under the kitchen or bathroom sink to determine the supply pipe material. You can also look at your water heater supply pipe.

Do your water supply pipes look like a penny?
Then they are copper!

Identify other plumbing features:

While you're checking, see if there is a point-of-use water filter similar to the ones pictured below:
