California Water Service Company (“Cal Water”) hereby respectfully requests authority to make changes to the tariff schedules below for its Grand Oaks District. ***Please note that this advice letter will only be distributed electronically to the Water Division and the attached service lists.***

Request

Cal Water requests permission to increase its revenues by 2.9%, the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for 2024.

Background

Cal Water acquired the Grand Oaks water system at the direction of the Commission in D.07-05-053, which authorized Cal Water to continue to operate the system as a stand-alone Class D water system without any time limitation.

The present rates became effective on October 1, 2024, pursuant to Advice Letter 2531, which authorized an offset (CPI) rate increase of \$748, or 3.4%.

Discussion

AL 2555 is filed pursuant to Ordering Paragraph No. 1 of Decision 92-03-093 and Resolution W-4493, which authorized Class C and D water and sewer utilities to file a request for a CPI increase once a year by Advice Letter. The specific increase allowed for 2025 is 2.9% identified in a letter dated February 3, 2025, from the Water Division as the CPI for 2024.

This increase is calculated by increasing the individual quantity rate and service charge components by 2.9%. The projected revenue increase of \$657 will not result in a rate of return that exceeds the authorized rate of return of 12.75%.



Requested Effective Date

Under General Order 96-B, Water Industry Rule 7.3.1, this is a Tier 1 advice letter. Cal Water requests that the rates proposed in this advice letter become effective on **July 1, 2025**.

Notice

Customer Notice – Customer notice of Tier 1 advice letters is not required under General Order 96-B, General Rule 4.2. In accordance with General Order 96-B, General Rule 3.2 the utility shall inform its customers, by bill insert in the first bill that includes the increase, of the amount of the increase expressed in dollar and percentage terms.

Service List – In accordance with General Order 96-B, General Rule 4.3 and 7.2 and Water Industry Rule 4.1, a copy of this advice letter will be transmitted electronically on **May 30, 2025**, to competing and adjacent utilities and other utilities or interested parties having requested such notification. ***Please note that this advice letter will only be distributed electronically to the Water Division and the attached service lists.***

Response or Protest

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest. A response or protest must be made in writing and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform the Water Division, within the 20-day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

The advice letter process does not provide for any responses, protests, or comments, except for the utility's reply, after the 20-day comment period.

Replies:

The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Each reply must be received by the Water Division within 5 business days after the end of the protest period and shall be served on the same day to the person who filed the protest or response. If you have not received a reply to your protest within 10 business days, contact California Water Service Company at 408-367-8200 and ask for the Rates Department.
